
Online video content, textbook published within the project and the Glossary of terms are very useful resources for students as well for teachers to learn Inclusive education concepts and practical activities.

Educational studies program "Modern education theory and philosophy" course

The results of the course were determined as follows, and the thematic plan of the lesson was developed and updated according to MELINC 3Teachers training for Inclusion project"

- 1.1. The theories and concepts of modern education (<u>Inclusive education</u>, sustainable development, life-long, global citizenship education) are explained with examples of social development.
- 2.1. Legal documents related to the implementation of modern education ideals in Mongolia are analyzed and evaluated.
- 2.2. New ideas and ways of implementing modern educational ideas and innovative technologies in training are proposed.
- 3.1. He shows his willingness to take a pluralistic approach to the new concept of education, express his position, and approach things creatively and proactively.

3 lectures (6 hours) and 6 seminars (14 hours) on IE included and organized in the content of the course. In the 2021-2022 academic year, 32 graduate students are studying this course.



In addition to using the PPT video presentation, pages 10-14, 85-86, 56-63, and 102-110 of the textbook "Inclusive education" were used to prepare the content of the lecture, and the seminar to determine the characteristics of inclusive students was conducted in practice 1.1 of the textbook. 1, 2.1.1, 2.1.2 and 3.1 are very appropriate and well developed.
